



Competitive Volunteer Coach Application

Introduction

Over the years, Niwot Youth Sports (NYS) has developed a history of serving the youth in the community through athletic competition. This history of successful service is largely credited to the dedication and skills of volunteer coaches, who selflessly give of themselves to teach and coach the community's young athletes.

Coaching our young athletes consists of more than creating a positive environment for our young athletes and demonstrating sport specific skills, rules and situational play. Coaching also includes setting a good example, serving as an adult role model for sportsmanship and community service, being prepared and well organized.

NYS will approve only one head coach for each team. Assistant coaches may be nominated by the head coach and must be approved by NYS. All NYS Volunteer Coaches will be accountable to the NYS competitive coordinator and/or NYS sport director and NYS president.

Application Requirements

1. All NYS competitive team coaches must apply for a coaching position to be eligible to coach each sport season.
2. NYS will submit basic information to the Colorado Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to complete a background check. Successful completion of a CBI background check is required to be eligible to coach within NYS.
3. The NYS Competitive Volunteer Coach Application consists of:
 - Basic Information
 - Qualifications
 - Organization
 - Team Plan
4. The NYS competitive coordinator and/or NYS sport director and the NYS president or his/her appointee will review, assess and approve NYS coach applications.
5. NYS Competitive Program coaches may be subject to more stringent application standards than NYS Recreational Program coaches.
